What is self-confidence? The Cambridge Dictionary defines it as "the belief that you can do things well and that other people respect you".

Do you have this type of self-confidence? The one where you sincerely believe that you can do things well enough that other people respect you?

Let's take a biblical look at a woman who had selfconfidence and was well respected by both men and women.

Reading from the book of Judges chapter 4, we meet Deborah. Deborah was a judge, the only female judge at a time when men dominated leadership positions. During this time the Israelites were in Canaan for 20 years, under oppression by King Jabin. i

The bible does not go into specifics as to why the Lord chose Deborah as a judge. But He clearly saw something in her that no man possessed at the time. She was an exceptionally talented woman. Apart from being a judge she was a wife, possibly a mother, a prophet, a poet, and a military leader.

As a judge the Israelites went to her when they needed advice and counsel. However, Deborah was best known for leading the Israelites to victory against King Jabin.

The Lord felt it was time to deliver Israel from their suffering. Deborah summoned Barak and told him the Lord commanded he take 10,000 men to fight Sisera, Commander of Jabin's army. However, Barak told Deborah he would only go if she went with him. This shows the level of trust and respect Barak had for her. However, because of the stance he took, Barak would not get credit for defeating Sisera. The credit went to a woman by the name of Jael, who killed Sisera while he lay in her tent.

So, the Lord gave them victory. To celebrate, Deborah composed a song of praise to God, which she and Barak sang together (Judges 5). After this the Israelites experienced 40 years of peace under Deborah's leadership.


You can see that Deborah possessed a level of confidence that Barak certainly did not have. She displayed leadership skills by going the extra mile to accompany Barak into battle.

What can we learn from this biblical account? Just as God blessed Deborah with exceptional talents, He has also blessed you. He gave you abilities to go out there and do the work he created you to do.

The bible states "we are God's masterpiece. He created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago" Ephesians 2:10.

By surrendering your life to Jesus, you can accomplish great things. What are your talents? What are the things you are good at? How are you using your gifts to glorify God and serve others?

When you use your talents to the fullest, you build self-confidence and the respect of others, just as Deborah did.

## PRAYER

Prayer is a fellowship with God. It is a way of communing with God. As a believer, we must have the right posture towards prayer.

1 Thess 5:17 Pray without ceasing. The ceasing the Bible is telling us here is praying always. A believer that doesn't have a prayer life has no walk with God. As a believer we need to build a prayer life rather than having prayer points.

I will say that there is no Christian Life without a prayer life. For a believer to have a solid walk with the Lord, such believer must have a solid prayer life. Let us look at keys to effective prayer life.

#### **Keys To Effective Prayer Life**

Faith: As a believer, we must believe that God is willing and able to hear us. We pray until we receive answer to our prayers.

Mark 11:23 Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him. A believer must learn to hold onto the promises of God. Believe that that which God has said in his word.

Romans 4:20 No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God.)

We see father Abraham here that he stay on the promises of God, even when the situation was saying otherwise, he still choose to belief God.

Consistency: There is no solid walk with the Lord without a consistent prayer life. James 5:16 Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working.) The emphasis I want to lay here is earnest, heartfelt and continued. Prayer must be a continuous act, prayer is not done once in awhile, it must also be heartfelt. Your body should know you prayed. I will also say that prayer is a deliberate act, know what you're praying about or prayed about. Anything you don't consistently do is not part of you, for prayer to be part of you, it must be done consistently.



# 1 Thess 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

Praying in the will of God: This is a very important key to know. A believer must come to know the will of God concerning what is been prayed about. If a believer is trusting God over a sickness or financial lack, the believe must first understand the will of God concerning such matter. James 5:14-15 Is anyone among you sick? He should call in the church elders (the spiritual guides). And they should pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Lord's name.

And the prayer [that is] of faith will save him who is sick, and the Lord will restore him; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. We understand from this passage of the Bible that the will of God is that the sick get healed. This also applied to financial lack, God want us to prosper. 3 John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and [that your body] may keep well, even as [I know] your soul keeps well and prospers. We see here that God want to us prosper in every way. In Colossians 1:9, Ephesians 1:17, we see apostle Paul praying for the saints in the will of God. It is the will of God that a believer have his needs met, so a believer must pray in this reality.

Expect Answers to Prayers: As believers, when we pray, we must expect Answers. We should be expectant. When we read 1 Kings chapter 17 and 18 we see how Elijah prayed that there shouldn't be rain and how he also prayed for rain. Let's see 1 Kings 18:41-45 And Elijah said to Ahab, Go up, eat and drink, for there is the sound of abundance of rain. So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he bowed himself down upon the earth and put his face between his knees And said to his servant, Go up now, look toward the sea. And he went up and looked and said, There is nothing. Elijah said, Go again seven times. And at the seventh time the servant said, A cloud as small as a man's hand is arising out of the sea. And Elijah said, Go up, say to Ahab, Hitch your chariot and go down, lest the rain stop you. In a little while, the heavens were black with wind-swept clouds, and there was a great rain. And Ahab went to Jezreel. We see how Elijah sent servant up to seven times to check the rain just because he was expectant. We become expectant in prayer by remaining in faith.

I often tell people that if they want to hear God's voice, they need to commit to being a student of God's Word. You know Why?

Because God uses His Word as the primary way to speak to us. The Bible is filled with His wisdom, instruction, and commands—it is full of information about His will for our lives.

The Bible is full of truths, instructions, stories, and parables to instruct us in every area—our behavior, our relationships with God and others, how to grow spiritually, how to discern right from wrong, ways to fulfill God's calling for our lives, and so much more.

The truth is, there are a lot of "voices" we can listen to in life. And while it's great to receive counsel and good advice from other people, we ultimately need to know what God has to say. I can't tell you how many times the Lord has used His Word to give me direction about my life or even simply speak a word of encouragement at just the right time.



Are there things you do well quite effortlessly? Are there things you always find yourself doing again even after stress had made you abandon them, things you believe people should see that you can do and only need to get better?

Then you have found yourself a skill! Come with me while I share some tips that has worked for me 1) USE YOUR HOBBY

Now that you already know what you are passionate about, start working on becoming better Sometime back, I discovered that I could pen down my thoughts in words better, I could go on writing on pages after pages. I then went on facebook because I was more current there, searched for groups related to writing and joined the very active ones. I knew this by going through their previous posts. I took my time to observe and pen down knowledgeable posts that could be of help to me.

You need to read books for an indepth insight on that skill you have. Thank God there are now audio books if you find it difficult to read . You can deliberately commit to reading one chapter or read for 20 minutes a day at your own pace.

After a while,I began asking questions on the group about books I should read and I was given recommendations a lot(this is the importance of active groups). Some of the books were free,some gave me links to blogs I could learn from while some books were to be paid for. Of course,I picked those I could afford

#### 3) FIND A TEACHER

It is important that you connect with people who are more experienced than you are. These people don't have to mentor you one on one,you can just follow them on social media and begin take note of their posts. Frankly, they may not even have your time unless you are paying of course.

I have a list of people I have been learning from on daily basis and they don't even know me. When I have the money, I will probably contact them for mentorship.

#### 4) TAKE A COURSE

If you find it hard to dedicate time to self learning, then committing to a course either online or classroom might be what you need. Online courses are of great help I can indeed testify to them. Create pages, follow figures, join groups, connect with people with whom you exchange Ideas and get better. You may not want to post but watch what others are doing that works and what doesn't. Follow current trends on an ongoing basis.

However,if you already have skills like hairdressing,fashion designing,photography,Make up,Catering etc ,Ensure you create a presence on these platforms,become well known and see how sales would boom

#### 8) BOOK AN EVENT

Attend seminars, join up with like- minded people and start working on projects together. Use "MEETUP" to find events that are around you and attend them to open your eyes and mind around your skills.

But the answer was as elusive as silence during a family dinner.

"I need your help," I told hubby, a whine in my voice and frustration oozing from my pores.

"About what?" he asked.

"I have a decision."

"Yes?"

I laid out my dilemma.

A lady who I admired, had called and told me that she had been praying and my name had jumped to her mind.

Well, that made me sit up and listen a little closer.

She spoke about how she knew I was organized and good at running things. She had noticed my people skills.

I sat up even taller and felt like a cat getting petted.

She explained how she was stepping down from an important role within an organization we both belonged to, and she was wondering if I would take her place. She assured me I would be the perfect fit.

Wait, whoa! She had a big job. She was important. She ran a large part of the organization. I slouched a bit. This conversation had not gone the way I thought it would.

I asked her some questions: Time commitment? Big. The duties? Lots. Pay? Volunteer status.

She encouraged me to pray about it and get back to her. I hung up conflicted.

I was trying to explain this to my husband. How it was a great opportunity. I would be doing lots of important stuff. And just imagine, she thought of and asked me to take over this job. Me. It was all so flattering and ego stroking.



#### What motivates your decisions?

And yet, it would take a lot of time. Family time. Daily time. There would be a learning curve. Did I really want to tackle this job when I was focusing on other opportunities? Would it be too much or cut into our precious family time?

I had prayed about it. No real answer had emerged.

My hubby listened to me paint this picture and name my dilemma. "Do you want to do this job?" he asked.

I hesitated and sidestepped the question. "I know I would be good at it. I know they need me. I feel flattered that I was considered."

His face wrinkled into frustration. "Yes, but do you really want this job?"

I wanted to be honest. "Not at this time of my life. But I feel guilty about turning it down. I feel guilty about disappointing her."

"Say no," he said.

"What?"

"Theresa, you should never make a decision based upon guilt or shame. When you do, you will come to regret that decision." I let his words sink in. Yes, I was feeling guilt over both accepting and declining the job. Guilt smeared and spread around for both yes and no. Guilt I was self-manufacturing. It wasn't easy calling the lady back, but I did. Telling her no. But then I felt much better.

Guilt and shame are unhealthy task masters. Often causing more guilt and shame, which we usually direct at ourself or others.

When guilt and shame motivate us to do something or decide something, they never promote peace and joy. They instead promote fear. Fear of disappointing and of doing the wrong thing. These fear based decisions than sprout resentment, anger, regret, and frustration.

Peace and joy come from God. Fear, shame, and guilt come from our enemy.

To help me visually remember to look at the motivation behind my decisions, I wrote on a sticky note: "Decisions based on guilt and shame are always bad decisions." I underlined 'bad decisions' and stuck it by my desk.

This world has enough guilt and shame, which promotes fear within us. And then we guilt and shame ourselves plenty, plenty. I instead want to be like God. He doesn't shame us into loving him. Guilt us into loving our neighbor. No, he uses plain old-fashioned encouragement and love.

Love casts out fear. Love erases guilt and shame. I John 4:18 "Perfect love casts out fear."

At the bottom of my sticky kitchen note, I wrote, "God uses Love," and drew a heart.

Leave shame and guilt out of your decision making. And instead, chose to be motivated by love.

Etiquette also refers to behaving in a socially responsible way any and every where you're opportuned to be, be it among the low, high or mighty.

There's no limit to how one is expected to behave when it comes to moral uprightness for so much is expected of and from individuals, upbringing regardless.

It is very possible, the kind of environment you find yourself in affects you either positively or negatively based on what you have been used to overtime, but even then, there is nothing such as an non-adjustable moral, character or comportment.

Although difficult it may seem when trying to evolve or go through a process of transformation from a poor moral to a solid sound one, it is actually achievable once it becomes a deliberate decision that is kept in place with consistency.

The very first step should be to know exactly what level of positivity and excellence in moral standard you'd want to evolve into and then follow through gradually until it becomes an absolute part of you.

So you see, it isn't difficult at all to culture sound Etiquette as long you desire them to be part of your life and conduct. Now, having seen more guides into what Etiquette is from the above, it is noteworthy to actually establish in a simpler term what Etiquette really means to avoid ambiguity. So....in simpler terms,

Etiquette refers to guidelines which control the way a responsible individual should behave in the society.

- ° Etiquette makes you a cultured individual who leaves a positive mark wherever you go.
- ° Etiquette teaches you the way to talk, walk and most importantly behave in the society.

    - It helps one become even the more responsible and mature.

°Etiquette helps individuals to value relationships.

Looking at it from the biblical aspect too, even the GOLDEN RULE in Matthew 7:12 looks ethical such that it advises us especially in our dealings with others to treat them as exactly as we would have them do to us.

It says:

"Here is a simple, rule-of-thumb guide for behavior: Ask yourself what you want people to do for you, then grab the initiative and do it for them. Add up God's Law and Prophets and this is what you get. - MSB

"Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. - KJV

No one is exempted from this, not even the believer in Christ.

As believers in Christ, much more is expected of us because we are patterned after Him and should reveal His personality in all we do, but this is not without the help of the HolySpirit helping us manifest the fruit of the Spirit (read -Galatians 5:22-23) in our daily living, maybe we should even call them Spiritual Etiquettes for they are there to sharpen and shapen us to live our lives such that it is pleasing to God and in doing so, we are actually shining our light before men that they see it and give glory to God on our behalf (read Matthew 5:16).

And of course, you shouldn't expect to be treated like a queen when all you do is treat others like some sort of garbage. Show some courtesy!

Prov.4.7 - Above all and before all, do this: Get Wisdom! Write this at the top of your list: Get Understanding!

Knowing what you ought to know, getting Wisdom and an accurate understanding of what should be done, when it be done, how it should be done and where it should be done is a good way to display Etiquette.

It is also important to note that when it comes to Etiquette it's totally about what should be or should not be done when it comes to certain areas of life especially the social aspects where we have to both deal with others and even work on ourselves.

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
